The Commissioner for Human Rights is an independent body of the Council of Europe entrusted with the tasks of promoting the effective observance and full enjoyment of human rights in Europe. To this end, the Commissioner addresses reports, recommendations and opinions to the Committee of Ministers and the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe as well as to the authorities of its 47 member States.

You have brought to the Commissioner's attention your concerns regarding the difficulties faced by Rüdiger Steinbeck, Hans-Jürgen Graf and Thomas Müller.

However, according to his mandate, the Commissioner is not empowered to take up individual complaints. Since your communication falls under this limitation, I regret to inform you that no specific action can be taken to address the issue raised by you.
